- Recruit at least two new members each year (in accordance with the agreed recruitment policy); and/or
- Contribute at least 100 USD annually to the Rotary Foundation

Our meetings are bilingual (i.e. our members use both Swedish and English) to promote an inclusive atmosphere and encourage guests to attend.
